Again, that one moment still remains the foundation for all the quantum leaps I attained in my entire teaching career.

Today, I can confirm that everything I have become is an offshoot of some of the training I received in Greensprings School. To this end, on the occasion of her 40th anniversary, may GSL continue to pass for a thriving environment for rewarding possibilities.


