## Year One Term 1 Curriculum Guide 2017/2018 Session

### English

We will:

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words, read words with contractions, read accurately by blending sounds in unfamiliar words containing graphemes
- Listen to and discuss a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction texts.
- Link what we read or hear to our own experiences.
- Form lower-case letters, upper case letters, numbers 0-9 in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.
- Learn to compose sentences orally before writing them
- Learn to use capital letters to start the names of people and places.
- Identify incidents in stories
- Identify naming words in sentences.
- Identify special naming words in sentences.
- Use -ing, -ed, -er and -est where no change is needed in the spelling of root words
- Read rhymes with predictable patterned language.
- Find out information about things using simple texts.

### mathematics

We will explore:

- Numbers to hundred (number names, comparing, ordering etc.)
- Measurement
- Properties of shapes

### art

We will:

- Create self portraits.
- Make use of colour in portrait painting.
- Paint portraits.
- Make a collage portrait
- Explore pointillism

### computing

We will:

- Explore computer parts and their uses
- Develop familiarity with computer keyboard
- Use a paint package to create a picture to communicate their ideas
- Represent data on pictogram.
- Write an algorithm on simple daily activities.

### PE

Pupils will:

- Explore the skills and tactics over a range of team games.
- Develop their understanding that the skills and tactics can be applied to a range of sports and are inter-transferable.
- Explore the techniques for water safety and competence, linking to real life situations, as well as the basic skills of freestyle swimming
- Acquire skills that will develop from basic to complex skills that can be applied over a range of sports
- Explore the accurate replication of techniques of basic to complex movements in Gymnastics and Dance.

### science

Pupils will:

- Identify ways of finding out scientific issues
- Explore parts and functions of parts of a plant.
- Sort plants into simple groups using their senses
- Identify living and non living things

### geography

We will inquire about:

- The different weather conditions and seasons in our home and host country
- How weather affects different plants.



## English

Pupils will learn to:

- Sequence sentences to form short narratives
- Punctuate sentences using capital letters, full stops and question marks
- Use grammatical terminology in discussing their writing
- Identify where a story takes place
- Identify characters in a story
- Identify incidents in a story
- Read labels and make a list
- Find information about things using simple texts.

## history

Pupils will:

- Explore different types of jobs.
- Find out about aspects of the past from a range of sources of information.
- Develop their understanding about jobs that are related in their duties.

## NCS

Pupils will explore:

- The importance of education
- Learn to exchange greetings in Yoruba and Hausa
- The Yoruba Alphabet
- Recreational games.

## mathematics

Pupils will:

- Add and subtract one and two -digit numbers
- Differentiate between 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Learn to tell the time
- Explore position and direction.

## French

Pupils will learn to:

- Exchange greetings and make introductions
- Count to 10
- Name classroom objects
- Name days of the week and professions
